"Shake Them Dreads"	4	Enthusiastic and informative essay that corresponds to a 4 Advanced in the following ways: • Topic is presented by naming popular rap artists (Bob Marley, Mac Dre, Damien Marley, and T-Pain) that show how cool and popular dreadlocks are. Writing takes topic from rap stars to ordinary people (Growing dreads is now a cool orderly fashion.) • Writing is organized through paragraphs that each address a different aspect of dreadlocks: how to grow them, what they look like, what some people associate with them. Ideas deepen and develop readers' understanding of dreadlocks. • Writing provides a thorough explanation of dreadlocks for those who are not familiar and in this way shows awareness of audience; language is appropriate and persuasive (They are one of the coolest fashion trends of our day.) • Language is specific (thick puffy Afro, natural oils, maintain, etc.) and sentence types are varied • Writing shows control of writing conventions though there are a few minor errors
Baseball Caps	3	Clear and direct presentation of baseball caps as a fashion trend. Organized presentation of information corresponds to a 3 Proficient: Introduction presents topic clearly. Writing explains how people wear baseball caps and includes some supporting details (dome-shaped flat bottom, they match with your clothes, etc.) Writing speculates about how the caps became a trend. Writing addresses audience. (Do you know what the cool thing about baseball cpas are?) Language is clear and there is some sentence variety and specific vocabulary. Several errors but they do not interfere with meaning
Jordans	2	Organized but brief paragraphs in a piece of writing about Jordans that corresponds to a 2 Developing: • Topic is presented right away; second paragraph slightly confusing (If it's the jersey or pants, then you wear it on you legs and torso.) Paragraphs not organized to support main ideas. • Although the writing presents lots of information about Jordans, the writing moves too fast and the ideas are not developed. • Because details are missing, writing shows little awareness of reader who is left with lots of questions (eg. How expensive are they? What are some of the other designs?) • General vocabulary; some sentence variety • Errors do not interfere with meaning. (kinda)
The loner trend	1	Brief piece that begins with an original fashion trend, but does not develop it. A "1" for these reasons: • Topic is unclear • Ideas are organized but writer is not engaged in the task or topic, so writing is confusing (Sometimes I see wild designs that look like thick fog.) • Writing does not show audience awareness • Language is clear; some sentence variety • Very few errors
