




Another reason watching TV is bad is because TV can influence kids in bad ways. There are many commercials advertising cigarettes and shows with



like fake guns, knives, etc. When they use real weapons, they're more likely to be dangerous with them.


Most kids think of bad things like the violence on television.

watch T.V at the same time.


